Frost delays are upon us, here are a few things to remember...

-Why it happens:

Frost forms when the temperature drops below freezing, causing moisture on the grass to freeze.

-Impact on the course:

Walking or driving on frosted grass can cause blades to break or uproot, leading to brown patches or dead grass.

-Etiquette:

Players are expected to respect the delay to preserve the playing surface for everyone.



Par 3 mats will be in play until the first signs of grass growth in the early spring.



Temporary greens will be in play when frost in present. Temp greens have been installed in the fairway on holes 1,2,3,4,5 & 9. We call this the "6 hole loop".
